ARENA

Standard (large) arena will be used for all classes. Schooling *will* be allowed in the competition arena prior to the beginning of the show and during breaks. Horses *will* be allowed in the competition arena during their warm-up immediately preceding their scheduled times. Both competition and warm-up arenas are indoors with climate control.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF, and MHSA rules will apply.
2. No braiding (unless you really want to).
3. Informal attire (including paddock boots and half chaps) allowed. All riders must wear competition-appropriate headgear.
4. The 2015 USDF and USEF Dressage will be used for all tests. The most recently published USEF Western Dressage tests will be used and are available at <http://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests/>. 2018 USEA Eventing Dressage Tests are available at <http://www.useventing.com/competitions/dressage/>
5. MAIDEN HORSE classes are open to **horses** which have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at an USEF, USDF, or MHSA recognized show. MAIDEN RIDER classes are open to **riders** who have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at a USEF, USDF, or MHSA recognized show.
6. In classes 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 48, 49, 50, 51 and 52, more than one test may be ridden but each test will carry a separate entry fee. State test(s) to be ridden on entry form. Classes will be split if entries permit.
7. All USEF/USDF dressage tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle, except Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional.
8. Ribbons through sixth place for all classes. High score ribbons given to the highest score earned each day in Introductory, Training, First, and Second Level and Above, and Western Dressage.
9. A negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted (copy) with entry and original must accompany each horse arriving on the grounds.

11. No dogs please!
12. Light concessions on show grounds; easy access to restaurants in the area.
13. **NOTE REFUND POLICY: Entries may be cancelled for any reason prior to midnight on the closing date. AFTER MIDNIGHT ON CLOSING DATE REFUNDS ARE POSSIBLE IF YOUR REASON IS COMPELLING!!**

FEES: Dressage classes	\$15 per class
Office fee	\$10 per horse/rider combination/weekend
Stabling	Extremely limited availability! \$100 for entire weekend (Friday afternoon through Sunday evening); \$70 for two days/one night. \$40 per day for day-only use (no overnight).
Jump-out (tying to trailer)	No charge

* **STABLING** is available on an extremely limited basis, preference given to out-of-town horses. Jump-out is available for no charge. Stabling fee includes all sawdust (not shavings) bedding.

DIRECTIONS: From I-70: Take Highway 54 West (exit 148) for approximately six miles toward Fulton and Jefferson City. Take the second Fulton exit (Route HH) and turn **LEFT** at the top of the ramp onto William Woods Ave. Follow William Woods Ave. for one mile and bear **RIGHT** at the "Y" intersection onto Westminster Ave. Turn **LEFT** onto 13th St. William Woods University stables are on the **LEFT**.

From Highway 54 South (headed northbound): Take third Fulton exit (route HH) and turn **RIGHT** on William Woods Ave. Follow direction as above.
