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### ENTRIES

- COMPLETE entries are taken on a first-come, first-served basis and must be postmarked by the closing date. Entries may close early if time limits for judging are filled. Remaining entries received before closing date will be placed on a wait list. Post entries will be taken, with priority going to horses already entered, as scheduling permits. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Only one horse-rider combination per entry. Entry must include all fees and signatures to be considered complete. No phone entries will be accepted. Sorry, no credit cards or online entries accepted. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- Send copies of proof of membership of owner, trainer, rider. Send copies of horse recording with USEF/USDF for qualifying classes. **Please use the forms generated at [www.eqverification.org](http://www.eqverification.org) if possible.**
- A current (dated within past 12 months) Coggins Test for the horse entered must be included with entry.
- Current proof (dated within past 6 months) of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations
- **Include certificate or proof showing completion of all three USEF SafeSport courses on USEF website.**
- Please Note: Except for USEF/USDF Championship classes and for FEI Pony Riders, FEI Junior, FEI Young Rider and FEI Para-Equestrian Freestyles, in order to enter a freestyle class at any level, a horse/rider combination must have received a minimum score of 63% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level at a Federation Licensed or FEI recognized Dressage Competition or "open" Dressage class (i.e. open to all breeds) at a Federation Licensed Competition held prior to the competition where the horse/rider combination is entered to ride a freestyle class. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility, or copy of the USDF score verification, must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class. BOD 8/27/18 Effective 12/1/18
- Due to facility constraints, no non-competing horses are allowed on the showgrounds.

### CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

**Times:** Ride times will not be mailed. Provisional stabling and unofficial times will be available at [http://www.shortenyourreins.com/www/19\\_spring\\_dressage/](http://www.shortenyourreins.com/www/19_spring_dressage/) (follow links) or by calling Karen at (573) 592-4343 during regular office hours (or leave message). Official times will be available at noon the day before the show. Management will make an effort to accommodate exhibitor requests regarding ride times, especially for riders showing more than one horse, but can make no guarantees. Please include any requests with entry.

**Schedule:** Classes will not necessarily run in the order listed in the class lists. Competitors should notify the show secretary of any conflicts/errors as soon as schedule is posted.

**Opportunity Classes:** These classes do not require owner/trainer/rider to hold USEF or USDF memberships nor pay the non-member fee. Horses in Opportunity classes are exempt from USEF drug fees; however, horses entered in Opportunity classes are still subject to and must comply with the Drug and Medication rules and are subject to drug testing. If the horse has a Horse ID or recording number, please include on entry blank. All other fees and USEF/USDF rules apply. Opportunity class results do not count toward end-of-year or qualifying requirements. **Horse/rider pairs entered in Opportunity classes MAY NOT cross enter into open classes.** Participants must abide by all USEF regulations pertaining to attire, tack and equipment for the recognized show. Reference USEF Rulebook, GR821 for additional information.

**Awards:** Divisions (Jr./YR, AA, Open) may be run concurrently as one class. Divisions will be pinned separately. Riders must clearly specify division choice. When no designation is made, riders will automatically be entered as Open. Riders may enter only one division per class. Ribbons through sixth place and trophies (for classes with at least 3 entries) for all classes. No awards for qualifying classes. Championship and Reserve awards at Intro - Fourth Levels, and FEI. To be eligible for championships, the horse/rider pair must compete in at least two tests in the level during the weekend, including the highest test offered. Scores from the three highest-scoring tests will be averaged to determine the winners.

**No-shows:** Failure to appear for a class at the scheduled time without prior notification of the show management may result in a "no-show" designation and may be scratched from the remainder of the show with no refund. No-show ride times may be filled.

**Refunds:** Prior to closing date, all fees of cancelled entries will be refunded, less a \$10/day office fee. After closing date, association fees will be refunded with valid vet or medical certificate. Class fees not refundable. All entries are made with this understanding.

**Food:** Food truck on grounds.

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### FACILITIES

**Scheduling:** This is a one-ring show. In order to accommodate as many competitors as possible, the show may start as early as 7 a.m. and run til 8 p.m. each day. Entries are made with this understanding. Competitors with more than one horse are encouraged to request first-horse-to-go and other scheduling adjustments, although no guarantees for accommodation can be made.

**Tests:** USEF and USDF 2019 tests, and appropriate current FEI tests will be used.

**Footing:** Competition will be held in a full-sized indoor arena with sand/sawdust/wood chip footing. Indoor warm-up in 90 x 200 arena with same sand/sawdust/wood chip footing. Outdoor warm-up/lungeing in sand arena.

**Arena Location:** Bleachers, stable offices and some horse stalls are situated less than 20 meters from the perimeter of the indoor competition arena. All entries are made with this understanding.

**Arena size:** All tests will be held in the standard (20m x 60m) arena.

**Stabling:** Stabling will be available in permanent stalls or portable tent stalls with doors and roof (10x10) with dirt floors. Sorry, due to limited stabling facilities, very limited tack stalls available. Stabling \$100 for duration of show (Friday afternoon through Sunday evening) in tents, \$130 for permanent 10 x 10 stalls with doors, or \$180 for extra-large (12 x 12) permanent stalls with doors (limited availability, first-come-first-served) or \$50 per <24 hours (e.g., arriving Friday morning and leaving Saturday evening would be two days). Bagged shavings available at \$7/bag. Please order bagged shavings at time of entry.

**Sharps disposal:** Competition management may fine any individuals including owners, exhibitors, trainers, or their agent up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Sharps disposals are available in the barn areas.

**Parking:** Due to limited space, exhibitors will be asked to park their unloaded trailers across Westminster Ave. Very limited tack stalls will be available; however, space will be available in front of/nearby stalls for equipment storage.

**Jump-out (working out of trailer):** Not available.

**Dogs:** Dogs must be contained or leashed at all times.

**Show numbers:** All horses must wear show numbers at all times when out of stall.

**Lungeing:** A dedicated lungeing area will be specified. No lungeing in designated warm-up areas.

**Smoking:** Absolutely no smoking in barns, arenas or on Equestrian Center premises.

**Pony Measurement:** Available Friday 4 p.m. Please contact show management to make appointment.

**Please note:** The William Woods University Equestrian Center is a working equine facility housing horses of multiple disciplines. Please make every effort to accommodate university horses, staff and students who are trying to complete their daily chores.

### Directions:

**From I-70:** Take Highway 54 West (exit 148) for approximately six miles toward Fulton and Jefferson City. Exit at the second Fulton exit (Route HH) and turn LEFT at the top of the ramp. Follow the road around a hard right turn (follow William Woods sign). Do not turn through the first WWU entrance: University stables are on the LEFT at 13th Street.

**From Highway 54 East:** Take third Fulton exit (route HH) and turn RIGHT. Follow direction as above.

**GPS Directions:** Do \*not\* use "William Woods University" as your destination -- you'll end up in the middle of campus. Instead, point your GPS system to the intersection of Westminster Ave. and 13th Street.

## ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

**Entry requirements for riders/owners:**

- Current USEF Card (or send application transaction receipt from USEF), OR \$45 USEF show pass fee
- Adults: **Include certificate or proof showing completion of all three USEF SafeSport courses on USEF website.** (New for 2019)
- Current USDF GMO or PM card (or send application transaction receipt from USDF) or \$35 USDF non-member fee
- Must sign entry blank Signature page in this prize list, completely signed with emergency number

**Entry requirements for GAIG/USDF qualifying. Rider and Owner needs:**

- To add \$15 qualifying fee per qualifying class
- Current USEF card and Current USDF PM card (or application electronic transaction receipt from USEF)
- Must sign entry blank Signature page in this prize list, completely signed with emergency number
- Owners of horses qualifying for Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Championships may also have a USDF Business Membership (BM).

**Entry requirements for Trainers/Coached:**

- (Trainer is person responsible for horse on grounds, not the rider's instructor. Coach is person paid for lessons at show.)
- Current USEF card (or send application electronic transaction receipt from USEF)
  - Must sign entry blank signature page in this prize list

**Entry requirements for Horses/Ponies:**

- USDF Horse Identification card/certificate or apply for HID card (send electronic transaction receipt from USDF)
- Current negative Coggins within one year, and Influenza/Rhino shot record within six months. If from out of state, current health certificate.

**If rider is trying to qualify for USDF Regional Championships, additional horse requirements:**

- USEF life or annual registration
- USDF lifetime registration
- Current USEF card and Current USDF PM card

**For Ponies:**

- Current or life USEF Pony Card or appointment for measuring with show's veterinarian and the show's USEF technical delegate. For measurement, see prize list details.

**Entry requirements for Opportunity Class riders/owners:**

- Opportunity riders and their horses do not need current USEF/USDF memberships, nor must they pay the showpass/

### **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**“Attention Competitors as of January 1, 2019, if you are a USEF competing member 18 years of age or older you are required to take the core Safe Sport training within 30 days of activating our membership. Take the Safe Sport Training at USEF.org by logging into your member dashboard.”**

### **Motorized Vehicle Statement, In accordance with GR1301.7:**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**Pony Measurements:** Any pony being ridden in a pony restricted class must possess a USEF Dressage Pony Measurement Card. A pony measurement is required for any horse under 8 years old which does not have a permanent pony measurement card. Owners must notify management of any ponies needing a measurement for an appointment to be scheduled with the veterinarian accordingly. The fee charged by the veterinarian will be prorated among the pony owners. This fee will only be the actual charge by the veterinarian and will not exceed \$100 per pony. Measurement fee will be paid directly to the veterinarian at the time of measurement. Do not prepay. Pony measurement will take place on Friday afternoon. If additional times are needed, they will be posted in the office on Friday evening. Measurement requests MUST be received prior to the start of the competition. A reminder of time and place for measurement will be posted in the show office on Friday. Owners must be USEF membership at the time of measurement. Ponies must have a USEF recording or HID #. Pony must be presented in a halter.

**Freestyles/Music:** Music for all freestyles on CD in WAV format must be given to the show office upon arrival to show grounds and check in to show office. Sound checks will be conducted Friday not before 5:30. Other times must be arranged with show management. The times for sound checks will be posted in the show office. Competitors are responsible to picking up their music before the end of the show. Music left will not be mailed. **Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:** Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

**Exceptions:**

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

**Memberships Defined**

**Participating Membership (PM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

**Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

**Education Membership (EM):** A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

**Non-Member (NM) Identification Number:** For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

**Horse Identification (HID) Number:** A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

**Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR):** A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

**How to Join USDF**

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.



## 2019 Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships

A single Regional Dressage Championship program organized by the United States Dressage Federation (USDF), and recognized by the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (USEF), will be held in each of the nine USDF regions. In addition, Alaska and Hawaii may each hold state championships if an official request from a Group Member Organization (GMO) is received by April 1 of the prior year. The Regional Championship Program Rules can be found on the USDF website at [www.usdf.org](http://www.usdf.org). Please refer to the 2019 USDF Member Guide for the comprehensive list of rules and requirements for this program.

### Membership/Registration Requirements for Qualifying and Championships

*All memberships and registrations/recordings must be correct and current at the time qualifying scores are earned and at the time of the championships.*

Rider:

- Must have a USDF Participating\* Membership (PM).
- Must have a USEF membership (Junior Active, Senior Active, or Life).

Horse:

- Must have a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR).
- Must have a USEF (Annual or Lifetime) Horse recording.
- USDF horse registration and USEF horse recording must be in the name(s) of the current owner(s) or lessee(s) of record. A horse is not required to have breed registry papers.

Owner:

- Must have a USDF Participating or Business Membership and a USEF membership (Junior Active, Senior Active, Life, or Recorded Farm (with Active Farm Owner)). If the horse has more than one owner, at least one owner must have both active USEF membership and active USDF Participating or Business Membership **and must be the owner of record with USEF and USDF**. For a business or farm to be the valid owner under this requirement, it must be listed as an owner of the horse with both USEF and USDF.

\* PMs are USDF members who join USDF directly. USDF Group Members (GM) are ineligible.

**Minimum Qualifying Scores:** One set of nationally-standardized qualifying scores has been established for all USEF/USDF Regional Championships, for Training Level through Grand Prix, in three divisions: open, adult amateur and junior/young rider. FEI Junior and FEI Young Rider classes have only one respective division. Freestyles have only open divisions.
